H & S/Code of Conduct

- 1: All riders/drivers must have a minimum of a restrictive civil drivers' licence, bike riders can race on a learners licence on an approved LAMs bike.
- 2: Any driver/rider that goes quicker than 11.00 seconds must have an IHRA/NZDRA drag racing licence.
- 3: All vehicles/bikes must have a current WOF and Registration. Any vehicle quicker than 11.00 must also have an IHRA/NZDRA drag racing tech. Any bike quicker than 10.00 seconds must also have a drag racing tech. A current MSNZ logbook and licence can be used as long as the vehicle does not go quicker than 10.00 seconds
- 4: All bike riders on street legal bikes must wear a helmet, closed in shoes and long pants. It is highly recommended that a bike jacket and gloves be worn. For competition bikes, please refer to the official IHRA NZ rulebook
- 5: All drivers in a street legal car must wear a helmet and closed in shoes. For competition vehicles, please refer to the official IHRA NZ rulebook
- 6: All speeds on the return road and pits must be kept to a minimum – or 10kmh as signposted.
- 7: No alcohol is to be consumed in the pit area while the track is open for racing.
- 8: All officials must be obeyed during racing.
- 9: No burnouts/skids at the end of the track, return road, entrance road, pits and head of stage.
- 10: For all speed and time offences, one warning will be given, second breach the driver/rider will not be allowed back on the track.
- 11: Strictly NO dogs on site.
