Street Car safety rules

If a vehicle runs a 10.59 or quicker without a log book, licence, current tech inspection and required safety gear, they will be banned from racing for a minimum of 12 months, no second chances, to return to racing the driver and car must have the correct credentials

If a vehicle runs between 10.79 and 10.60 they will be removed from racing (no second chances), that vehicle must get a tech/log book and the driver a race licence before it can race on the track again.

If a vehicle runs between a 10.99 and 10.80 they are out of racing for that meeting, it is highly recommended that they tech/log book their vehicle. If they return without the correct credentials and run another 10.99 or quicker they will be banned from racing for a minimum of 12 months

When a driver is banned so is the vehicle, if a racer changes plates or the look of the vehicle to get around the rules, they will face up to a 5-year ban. No time slips will be handed out for any vehicles that are not legal and break the rules.

Any offending racers may have their name publish

These rules are for any track/private or promotor event.

Meremere will deal with all infringements on a case by case basis
